# How We Help

#### **DEFINING THE NEED**

During fiscal year 2022, 18,225 children in the St. Louis area were reported to the Missouri Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline.

#### **MAKING AN IMPACT**

4,395 children, their families, and community members were served by FamilyForward in 2022.

#### **METHODS**

The agency's overarching philosophy is based in the Neurosequential Model of Therapeutics™ (NMT), developed by Dr. Bruce Perry. NMT is a trauma-informed, developmentally sensitive approach to understanding the impact of a child's history on current functioning. Guided by NMT, FamilyForward's comprehensive services support the child, family, and broader community.

## TRAUMA ASSESSMENT AND PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATION

Trauma assessment and psychological evaluations with individualized recommendations to support children at home, in school, and with therapeutic interventions

## **THERAPY**

Individual, family, and group counseling using evidence-based practices

## **EDUCATION AND TRAINING**

Comprehensive, high-quality training and education opportunities for professionals, educators, and caregivers

#### **FOSTER CARE AND ADOPTION**

As a Children's Permanency Partnership member, FamilyForward provides foster care and adoption case management, recruitment, training, and licensing services for foster and adoptive families

#### THERAPEUTIC PRESCHOOL

Highly structured environment utilizing developmentally sensitive interventions for children experiencing emotional and behavioral difficulties

## **HOME VISITING SERVICES**

Mentoring, parent coaching and education, and therapy services for young and pregnant parents and families

#### **OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY**

Integrated occupational therapy to address sensory and motor skill deficits
